## **Carbon footprint of NN Group's proprietary assets**

Carbon footprinting can help us understand carbon and climate change-related risks within our investment portfolio and can also be useful to inform corporate engagement. In the context of an investment portfolio, a carbon footprint measures the amount and intensity of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions associated with the underlying portfolio holdings. Emissions are expressed in carbon dioxide equivalents (CO<sub>2</sub>e).

To be consistent with internationally recognised standards, NN is continuously updating and improving its methodology. Carbon footprint measurement and reporting remains an area for ongoing development. As such data improvements and refinements of our methodology may affect our carbon footprint analysis in future years.

Information provided in this table is based on an analysis of our main asset categories; government bonds, corporate investments, residential mortgages, and real estate investments. Taken together this represents 80% of the total asset portfolio on our balance sheet, which comprises general account assets of the insurance entities, and the assets of NN Bank and NN Group.
