This document must be read in conjunction with the base prospectus pertaining to the Programme, dated 18 July 2024 as supplemented on 18 February 2025 and any further amendments and supplements thereto (the "**Base Prospectus**"), which constitute a base prospectus for the purposes of the Prospectus Regulation. Full information on the Issuer and the offer of the Covered Bonds is only available on the basis of the combination of these Final Terms and the Base Prospectus and any amendments or supplements thereto and the terms and conditions set forth in the Base Prospectus.

- buildings that have been renovated, resulting in a reduction of PED of at least 30 per cent.; or
- buildings that have been renovated meeting the criteria for major renovation.

The envisaged impact of the issue of the Green Covered Bonds is a reduction and/or an avoidance in greenhouse gas emissions as a result of a lower degree of carbon intensity of the Issuer's Eligible Green Loan Portfolio versus the baseline in the Netherlands. The way in which the reduced and/or avoided greenhouse gas emissions will be calculated will be clearly outlined in post-issuance reporting documents, which for the avoidance of doubt are not part of the Issue.
